To hold a hearing to hear new evidence into the unmodified part of the Order and, concurrently, hold a hearing into the Inspector's proposed modifications to the Order as contained in his letter dated 12 February 2024.

The appointed Inspector will also open the Hearing as a virtual event on **Tuesday 4 February 2025** at 10.00am.

Anyone wishing to attend the Hearing virtually must register that interest with the Order Making Authority by 4pm on Monday 3 February 2025, by telephone or by e-mail, details of which are set out in this notice. To take part using video, participants will need to have access to Microsoft Teams (via an app or web browser). The link <https://support.microsoft.com/en-us/office/welcome-to-microsoft-teams-b98d533f-118e-4bae-bf44-3df2470c2b12> gives further information on how to use this. Alternatively, you can take part by telephone. Registered participants will receive individual joining instructions, providing details of any requirements, guidance and support, whether joining by Teams or telephone.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed as made, would be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading to a bridleway the public right of way, (Path no.8 Trowbridge, Church Lane), leading from its junction with Frome Road at OS Grid Reference ST 8427-5629, in a generally north-westerly direction for approximately 294 metres to its junction with Path no.9 Trowbridge at OS Grid Reference ST 8407-5648, and varying the particulars relating to Path no. 8 Trowbridge by providing a recorded width varying between 4 metres and 13 metres, as shown on the Order Map.

The effect of the proposed modifications would be to provide for the following:

- Delete '*in green*' from the first line of the description in Part I of the Order Schedule.
- Delete '*in green*' from the fifth line of the description in Part I of the Order Schedule.

- Delete the sixth and seventh lines from the description in Part I of the Order Schedule.
- Replace '4m' in the seventh line of the description in Part II of the Order Schedule with '7m'.
- Add at the end of the description in Part II of the Order Schedule:

'Limitations

The Wiltshire Council may permit posts or bollards to be erected between points X and Y on the Order Map to prevent use by mechanically propelled vehicles'.

- Include the remainder of Church Lane within the Order Map and add points X and Y at the appropriate points.
- Modify the key to the Order Map to reflect the extent of the route.

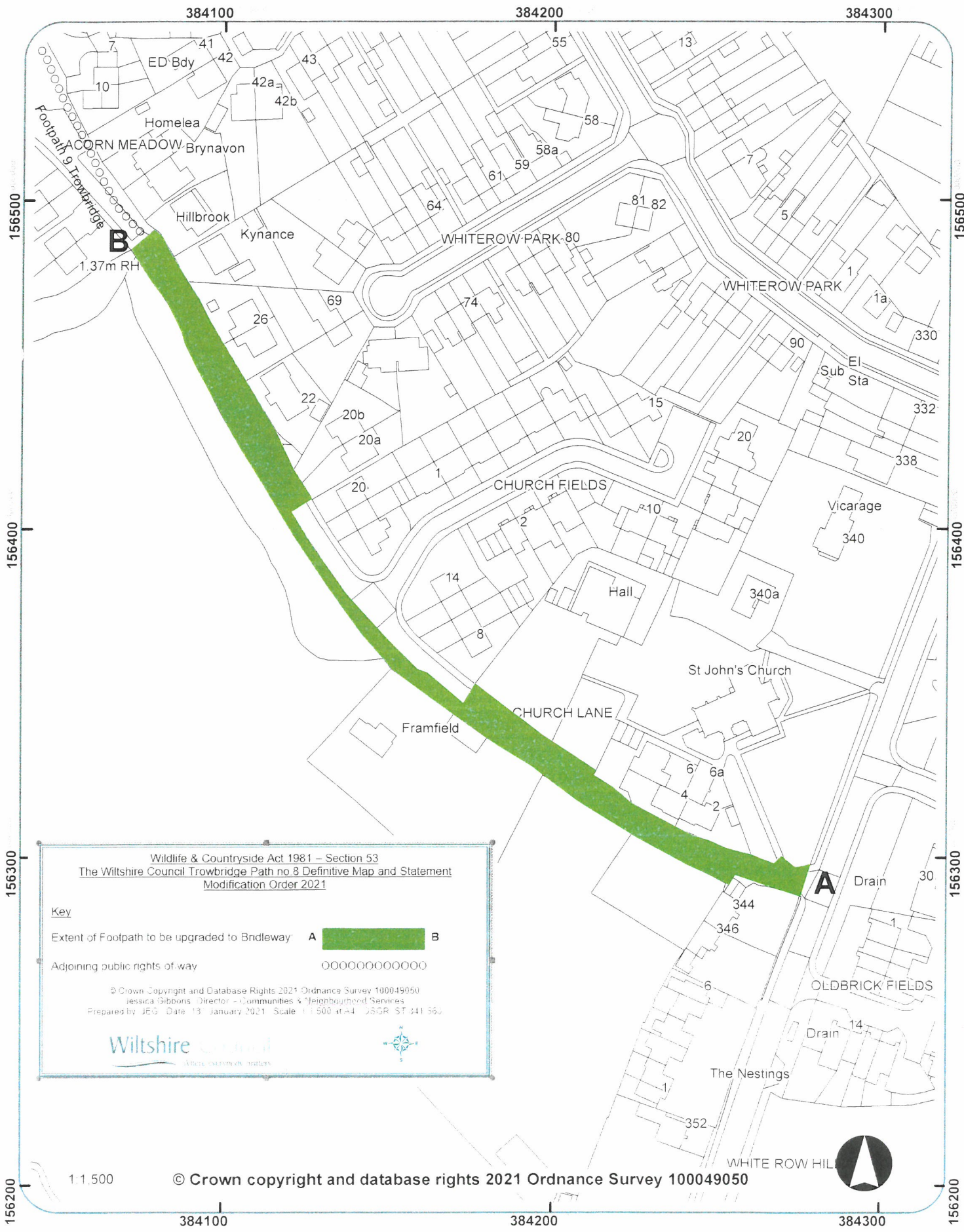
